David Harber unveils brand new sculpture in collaboration with British fine jeweller Annoushka Ducas

Oxfordshire, UK: David Harber is delighted to unveil a brand-new sculpture; *Sycamore*, an exquisite piece designed in collaboration with luxury British jeweller Annoushka Ducas MBE.

Both Harber and Ducas share a mutual love of the great outdoors and have each brought their expertise to the piece – technical prowess from David, and playful femininity from Annoushka. The finished piece was inspired by Annoushka's iconic 18ct gold Sycamore Charm.



Sycamore – a piece that transcends functionality becoming jewel-like for the garden, rotating slowly with elegance and versatility. Sycamore provides its user with a moment of respite and tranquillity, inviting you to indulge peacefully in its setting.

Standing 1.75m high, it features delicate latticework, creating mesmerising shadows on the ground below, while the seat is covered in intricate leaf details. The entire piece is hand-crafted in David's Oxfordshire atelier from stainless steel and finished in an illustrious pearl gold.

Sycamore is a first for both David Harber and Annoushka and the first time the British jeweller has designed a piece on this scale.

Sycamore is a limited edition run, with just twelve pieces in production, making it a covetable sculpture for discerning homeowners looking for something truly unique.



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Like all pieces in Harber's portfolio, Sycamore is lovingly crafted at Harber's rural workshop in Oxfordshire by a skilled team of engineers. Painstaking attention to detail goes into each and every design, and every sculpture that leaves the workshop is individually hand-finished. Harber truly believes in designing pieces to last - in the past he has referenced sundials dating back to the 16th century, and he has an applaudable vision that every David Harber design will act as an heirloom for future generations.

Speaking of the design, David Harber notes: "This is an incredibly exciting opportunity with a fellow creative. We are seemingly both inspired by nature; the primary difference being scale. Our sculptures can weigh, on occasion, many tons; whilst the delicate discipline of jewellery and Annoushka's exquisite pieces are measured in grams. The Sycamore, whilst inspired by nature, also provides somewhere to rest and repose and really immerse oneself in the landscape, as the sculpture seat can be gently rotated, providing panoramic views."

"There is so much beautiful texture and detail in nature - over the years I've reimagined everything from bugs and beetles to conkers and seeds in my jewellery designs- so to scale something up to nearly 6ft has been eye-opening!", adds Annoushka Ducas. "The Sycamore is one of my favourite charm designs - it makes me think of new beginnings and is said to represent strength and protection. David has done a wonderful job of retaining all the precious intricacies in the finished piece - with the added complexity of making the piece rotate. I can't wait to sit on it and have a spin!"
